## Sonata 7

The Sonata 7 is one of the most comfortable family cruising yachts available in the yachting market today. For a 23 footer it is extremely spacious down below.

Sleeping is provided by six berths and can accommodate an average family in complete comfort.

The separate galley includes built-in ice box, sink, store compartment and plenty of storage space under.

A separate toilet compartment is much more practical for family use than those which are located under bunks. Storage space is located under all berths and other lockers conveniently placed throughout the yacht.

A large pop top provides standing headroom and plenty of fresh air.

The cockpit is large and self draining. There are lockers built in for fuel tanks, ropes, fenders etc. Small coaming lockers are for small items such as sunglasses, sun lotion etc.


The forehatch is perspex alloy framed for access to the foredeck and anchor well, as well as providing light and ventilation.

The rigging is a simple masthead configuration with all controls leading back to the cockpit which assists greatly when sailing short handed.

The new rudder blade stows vertically in its alloy rudder box for ease of trailering or launching.

The ball asted swing keel retracts fully into the hull requiring just a foot of water to float the yacht.

The fixed fin keel model has proven to be popular with those who prefer to permanently moor their yachts.

STAGE A - BASIC ASSEMBLY - Hull, deck, furniture moulding and headliner all bonded together. Windows cut out. Anchor well bonded in. Keel and winch fitted with positive lock down, towing eye fitted. All fibreglass hatches, gunwale strips and end caps and rudder blade supplied loose.

STAGE B - SAILAWAY YACHT - as above but with mast and boom assembled, gunwale strips, windows, hatches, pop-top mechanism, chainplates and main bulkhead fitted. 2 x Barlow 15 halyard winches and 2 x Barlow 16 sheet winches and cleats fitted. Main and jib sheet travellers and cars fitted. Mainsail with 2 reefs, battens and numbers and Jib (North or Hood sails)
